 Mendon Bank $\frac{1}{3}$ hundred dollars, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby
 give, grant, sell and convey unto the President, Directors and Compa-
 ny of the Mendon Bank, their successors and assigns forever, a certain
 tract or parcel of land, situate on the west side of the Providence
 and Worcester road in the First Parish in said Mendon, butted
 and bounded as followz, to wit, beginning at the centre of the Post at
