Yeoman in Consideration of Eighteen Dollars paid me by  
Amelia Wheelock of the same Sutton widow the receipt whereof I  
do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey unto  
the said Amelia Wheelock her heirs and assigns, a certain tract  
of tillage land situate in the southeasterly part of said Sutton, cont-  
aining one acre more or less, and is part of a tract set off to satisfy  
an Execution in favour of Hannah Walker, bounded as follows viz.  
beginning at the westerly corner by land of the grantee, thence S. 33°  
N. twelve & 1/2 rods to a stake and stones by land of the grantor, thence  
S. 30° E. sixteen & one half rods to stake and stones by the grantor,  
thence W. 34° South seven rods to a stake and stones by the grantee,  
thence W. 42° N. sixteen and a half rods to the first mentioned bound-  
- To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Amelia Wheelock  
her heirs and assigns, to her and their use and behoof forever. and I for my-  
self my heirs, Executors, and administrators, do covenant with the said  
Amelia Wheelock her heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in  
fee of the aforegranted premises; that they are free of all incumbrances;  
that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Amelia  
Wheelock and that I for myself my heirs, executors, and administrators,  
will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Amelia Wheelock  
her heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands  
of all persons. in witness whereof, I the said Simeon Hathaway together  
with Silence Hathaway my wife in token of her free relinquishment of  
her right of dower in the premises aforesaid have hereunto set our  
hands and seals this twenty fifth day of March in the year of our  
Lords one thousand eight hundred and twenty six -
