Whereas Adam Wheelock, of Mendon, in said County, Deponent, by the consideration of our Justices of our Court of Common Pleas, holden at Worcester, for and within our County of Worcester aforesaid; on the fifth Monday of August last, recovered Judgment against Daniel Tharber the second, of said Mendon, Cordwainer, for the sum of one hundred and fifty seven dollars and thirty one cents, damage, and seven dollars and eighty one cents, costs of suit, as to us appears of record, whereof execution remains to be done — We command you therefore, that of the goods chattels or lands of the said Daniel within your precinct, you cause to be paid and satisfied unto the said Adam at the value thereof in money, the aforesaid sum, being \$165.. 12 in the whole, with twenty five cents more for this Writ, and thereof also to satisfy yourself for your own fees, and for want of goods, chattels, or lands of the said Daniel to be by him shewn unto you, or found within your precinct, to the acceptance of the said Adam to satisfy the sums aforesaid, we command you to take the body of the said Daniel and him commit unto our Gaol in Worcester in our County of Worcester aforesaid and detain in your custody within our said Gaol until he pay the full sums above mentioned with your fees, or that he be discharged by the said Adam the creditor, or otherwise by order of law — Hereof fail not and make return of this writ, with your doings therin, into our said Court of Common Pleas to be holden at Worcester, within our County of Worcester aforesaid, on the first Monday of December next.
