Johnson Apollos (Know all men by these presents that I Apollos Johnson of Dana in the county of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Esquire in consideration of seventy dollars paid by Joab Young of Petersham in the county aforesaid yeoman the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Joab his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land in Petersham aforesaid containing seven acres be the same more or less bounded as follows to wit. beginning at a post at the Northwest corner of the bridge thence by land formerly owned by John Holland South 22 degrees East four rods and 8 links thence South 20 degrees East four rods & seventeen links thence South 18 1/2 West ten rods & 17 links thence South 28 fifty seven rods thence by land of John Chamberlin North 53 West sixteen rods & 19 links thence by the meadow North 22 East seventeen rods North 39 East eighteen rods thence North 35 1/2 East twenty five rods & 14 links thence North 53 East six rods and 3 links thence North 25 West across the brook two rods thence North 54 1/2 East five rods to the first bound it being the same conveyed to me by Robert butter. —
