

of wall thence South $47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West nine rods then South 54° West eleven rods and seventeen links then North $23\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West one rod and eleven links then South 50° West three rods then South 70° West one rod then South $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West two rods and fifteen links then South 47° West seven rods then South 64° West seven rods then South $58\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West thirteen rods then South 57° West twenty seven rods to the road near the dwelling house of Enos Taft all the above lines bounding Easterly and Northerly on land of William & Hastings, Charles C. Hastings and Mary M. Hayward thence on said last mentioned road South $35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East thirty six rods and six links to land of Nathan George then North $48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East twenty six rods and twenty links to a corner of wall then South $37\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East twenty two rods and twenty links thence South $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East six rods to the first mentioned road the three last lines bounding on land of Nathan George being the Johnson estate then on said first mentioned road North $27\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East thirteen rods and thirteen links to the centre of a ditch then up the centre of said ditch North 23° West forty five rods and sixteen links to the end of a wall then North $63\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East sixteen rods to end of a wall and a post then South 27° East twenty four rods and eleven links to a post at the corner of E.
