 by acknowledge do give grant sell and convey unto the said
 Charles C. Hastings his heirs and assigns the following
 described premises situated in said Mendon said land
 is bounded as follows to wit beginning at the corner of the
 wall at land belonging to Charles C. Hastings and Mary
 M. Hayward and running South $22\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 3 rods
 and 18 links then South $24\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East 7 rods and $24\frac{1}{2}$ links to
 the corner of the post at land owned by Charles H. Childs
 and Enos Gof bounding Westerly on land of the said
 Hastings and Hayward as the wall now stands thence
 turning and running North 63° East 3 rods and $18\frac{1}{2}$ links
 to the North West corner of the barn standing on land
 of the said Childs and Gof and bounding Southerly on
 said land of said Childs and Gof and formerly owned by
 Swelling and Davenport then turning and running North
 $25\frac{2}{3}^{\circ}$ West 12 rods and $17\frac{1}{2}$ links to a stake on the road
 leading from Mendon to Uxbridge and bounding Easterly
