

thence Northward by said Dennis's land to the county road aforesaid thence Easterly by said county road to the first mentioned bounds. — To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Nathan George his heirs and assigns to his & their use and behoof forever and I do for my self my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said George his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises that they are free of all encumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Nathan George and that I warrant and defend the same premises to the said Nathan George his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons — Provided nevertheless that if the said Lawrence Heegan his heirs executors or administrators pay to the said Nathan George his heirs executors administrators or assigns the sum of six hundred dollars in three years from the date hereof with interest to be paid annually then this deed as also a certain note bearing date with these presents given by the said Lawrence Heegan to the said Nathan George to pay the same sum as aforesaid at the times aforesaid shall both be void otherwise shall remain in full force — On witness whereof I the said Lawrence Heegan & Catharine Heegan wife of said Lawrence thereby relinquishing my right to dower or thirds in the aforesigned premises have hereunto set our hands and seals this sixteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty eight — Signed sealed and delivered Lawrence Heegan (seal)
