Page 288. — Do have and to hold the above released premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Cyrus Boyden and his heirs and assigns to his & their use and behoof forever and I the said Albert Gould for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Cyrus Boyden <sup>and his heirs and assigns</sup> that the premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me except said mortgage to said Hastings which was given to secure the payment of the sum of \$100 & interest and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Cyrus Boyden and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me except the mortgage aforesaid but against none other.
