Comstock of said Mendon and County and Commonwealth aforesaid Boot manufacturer. the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said William H. Comstock his heirs and assigns all that parcel of land situated in said Mendon bounded and described as follows Beginning at the North West corner of William H. Comstocks land thence North 83<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> degrees rod and seventeen links running and bounding on the Meeting House Common: thence North 85 East nine rods and twenty one and one half links bounding on land of the grantor: thence South 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> East one rod and seventeen links and bounding on land owned by David Staver port thence South 85 West ten rods to the first mentioned bound and running on land of Mr. H. Comstock with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto Belonging the said Comstock shall build and forever maintain a good and substantial fence on the line bounding on land of the grantor and his heirs and assigns shall be subject to the same condition

I have and to hold the aforesaid premises to the said Mr. H. Comstock his heirs and assigns to his and their several behoof forever and I the said Holland Albe do hereby for myself and my heirs executors and administrators covenant with this said Comstock his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in full imple of the aforesaid premises that they are free of all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Comstock and that I and my heirs executors and administrators will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Comstock his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons

To witness whereof I the said Holland Albe together with Rosanna Albe my wife who herein acknowledge I am the son of David in the premises and remitted to me two hands and seals this twelfth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five
