Know all men by these presents, that I Henry Galis of Hubbardston, County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of two hundred and forty Dollars paid by Asa Stone of Erimonton County and Commonwealth aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do give, grant, sell, and convey unto the said Asa Stone, his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land situated in the Easterly part of Hubbardston, and bounded as follows, viz. Beginning at a Stake and Stones on the Easterly line of a town road leading from the house of Aaron Wate to the house of Sampson Stone, it being a corner of said Stones land, thence running North 58° East on the line of said Stones land Sixty eight rods and a half rod to a Stake near Mooshorn Pond, thence North 34° West on the line of land of Dana Lyon and Silas Greenwood, about Eighty four rods and fifteen links to a Stake and Stones on said Greenwoods line, thence South $17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West about forty two rods to the road aforesaid thence Southerly by said road ninety nine rods to the first mentioned
