ufacturer the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
do give grant sell and convey unto the said Whelock his
heirs and assigns the following described piece of land
situated in said Mendon with all the privileges and
appurtenances to the same belonging bounded as fol-
lows to wits. beginning at a stake on the southwesterly
side of the old Hartford turnpike (so called) said stake
is eighty four feet and three inches from the southwesterly
corner of the store occupied by Aldrich & Brother and
one hundred and six feet and one half inch further
northwesterly corner of the new school house thence run-
ning southeasterly, bounding northwesterly on said
turnpike 85 feet & parallel to a corner near the store oc-
cupied by George H. Thayer - thence south 61° and 40' West
four rods & 14 links to a corner at a stake (bounding south
easterly on a land of Nathan Gurge) the stake last above
