

put in the place of it. the basement to extend the entire width of the building in the rear with windows to correspond with the ones on first floor. The privy to be brought down as low as the wood-work of the building and 4 stories instead of three the row of doors in the side to be placed further back say in the place of the next window toward the rear and windows in the place where the doors are now marked in the plan. The outside door in the attic to be as high as it can be and open inward. a door to be placed in the second story in front and the floor and the floor to extend through the colonnade and level with the 2^d story floor to be made water tight with hard pine floor and hand railed around the outside. The floors in the attic and cockloft to be of spuce 1 1/8 inch thick when worked tinged and grooved and worked to a thickness. three common windows in front gable end instead of the circular window. The enclosing to be northern white pine sound and free from loos knots and worked in the same way as specified for No. 4. eastern pine in the specifications. The window frames may be made tight with caps instead of lead where it can be done. The conductors may be made of wood instead of tin 4 by 4 and put together with white lead and well fastened. The upper and under floors of the basement to be of chestnut instead of pine wrought to a thickness and square edge.
