Boyden wife of the said Cyrus Boyden, for the consideration aforesaid, in token of her voluntary relinquishment of all her rights by and under the Homestead Exemption Laws of this Commonwealth as well as all right, claim or possibility of dower in said premises, have hereunto set our hands and seals this ninth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven.

Wheeler Adam D. This Indenture made this ninth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven by and between Adam D. Wheeler of Brooklyn, county of Kings and state of New York of the one part and Mary P. Boyden of Mendon, county of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Adam D. Wheeler doth hereby lease, demise and let unto the said Mary P. Wheeler a certain tract of land with the buildings thereon, with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, situated in Mendon aforesaid being the same premises conveyed to the said Adam D. Wheeler this day, by Cyrus Boyden to which deed reference may be had for a more particular description and for the boundaries. To hold to the lessee, the said Mary P. Boyden during her natural life from this day, the said lessee yielding and paying therefor to the lessor upon demand made the sum of one dollar annually. In witness whereof, the said Adam D. Wheeler hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day, month and year above written.
