And I, Gemma A. Adams, wife of the said David Adams, for the consideration aforesaid, do hereby release and quit-claim unto the said Thomas McAles, his heirs and assigns, all the right, title, claim or demand, which I may have in and unto the premises hereby conveyed, under or by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and also all right, claim or possibility of dower in said premises.
