

in said Mendon on the southerly side of the road leading from Milford to Uxbridge and bounded as follows: Beginning at a corner of fence at land of Anna St. Hastings at the Northeast corner of the premises hereby conveyed thence running southwesterly by and with said road 3 rods and 18 links to a corner at other land of said Hastings thence bearing and running southeasterly and bounded southwesterly by land of said Hastings as the fence, bank wall, and fence now stands 3 rods and 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ links to a corner at land of Charles H. Childs of Providence R. I. thence bearing and running Northwesterly bounding southeasterly as the fence and the Westerly side of the barn of said Childs now stands 3 rods 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ links to a corner of the land of Anna St. Hastings first mentioned, thence bearing and running Northwesterly as the fence now stands, bounding Northwesterly by land of said Anna St. Hastings 12 rods 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ links to the bound first mentioned at the road aforesaid.

To have and to

hold the above granted premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Davis B. Cook his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And I the said Thomas McClees for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Davis B. Cook his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized, in fee of the aforesigned premises that they are free from all incumbrances except a mortgage for three hundred dollars with interest since Sept. 1st 1863 now owned by David M. Bennett of said Mendon, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Davis B. Cook as aforesaid and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Davis B. Cook his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

On witness whereof I the said Thomas McClees and Susanna McClees wife of the said Thomas in token of her release of all right and title, or to both house and home lead in the granted premises have hereunto set our hands and seal this seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen.
