Morris. I, Alpha & others all men by these presents, that we, Alpha Morris, Widow, Eliab J. Morris, & Ann Morris, wife of said Eliab, Nathan W. Morris, and Alura Minette L. Weatherhead, Morris, wife of said Nathan W., Elias S. Dallou, Jr., William Henry Yillor & Alpha W. H. Yillor, wife of said William Henry, all of Barnstable, in the State of Rhode-Island, in consideration of Two hundred and eighty and five dollars, paid by Minette L. Weatherhead, of Mendon in the County of Worcester, and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, wife of Abel Weatherhead, of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby release, release and forever quit-claim, unto the said Minette L. Weatherhead, her heirs and assigns, a certain tract of land with all the buildings thereon, situated in said Mendon, on the northwesterly side of the road leading from the Store of Henry W. Aldrich, to Uybridge, bounded as follows - Beginning at a point on said road, at the southeasterly corner of said tract, at land of Henry W. Aldrich, thence northerly and bounded easterly on land of said Aldrich and land - Lydia E. F. Davenport, as the wall now stands, to a corner of wall, at land of William W. Aldrich, thence turning & running westerly and bounded northerly, on land of said William W. Aldrich, as the wall now stands, to a corner of fence and wall, thence turning & running southerly, and bounded westerly, on land belonging to the heirs of Charles B. J. Hastings, to the road, afore-mentioned, thence turning & running easterly and bounded southerly by said road, to the bound first mentioned, at the place of beginning. For a more particular description, reference is made, to a deed from Warier N. Stone to Addaide H. Stone, recorded in the Registry of Deeds, at Worcester, Book 484, Page 641. To have and to hold the above-released premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, to the said Minette L. Weatherhead, her heirs and assigns, to her and their use and behoof forever. And we the said Alpha, Eliab J. Morris, Nathan W., Alura, Elias S., William Henry & Alpha W. H. for ourselves, and our heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Minette L. Weatherhead, her heirs and assigns, that the premises are free from all incumbrances, made or suffered by us; and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and defend the same to the said Minette L. Weatherhead, her heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by, through, or under us, but against none other.
