And we Mary F. Fisher wife of the said Erastus Fisher & E. A. Fisher wife of the said H. D. Fisher for the consideration aforesaid, do hereby release and quit claim unto the said William A. Ferry his heirs and assigns, all right, claim, or possibility of dower in said premises together with all homestead rights.
