Wheelock. thence turning & running Westerly & bounded Southerly by land of said George 3 rods to a corner at land belonging to the heirs of Mary M. Hayward aforesaid. thence turning & running North-
erly and bounded Westerly by land belonging to the aforesaid heirs of Mary M. Hayward eight rods & about 10 feet, to the bound first mentioned at the place of beginning at the forementioned road.

To have and to hold the above granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Henry Morton Aldrich his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And I the said Henry A. Aldrich for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Henry Morton Aldrich his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee ^{simple} of the aforesigned premises that they are free from all incumbrances. that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Henry Morton Aldrich his heirs and assigns forever as aforesaid. and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Henry Morton Aldrich his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
