Barrows of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the further consideration that the said John J. Barrows having executed and agrees to provide for the comfortable maintenance and support of our mother, Clara Barrows, during her life, do hereby give, grant, bargain, release and convey and forever quitclaim unto the said John J. Barrows, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract of land with all the buildings thereon situated in said Mendon upon the Easterly side of the road leading from Mendon to Providence, R. I., and bounded as follows, viz: Beginning at the land of Warren Esty upon the road aforesaid, thence Northwesterly by and with said road to the intersection of a County road leading from Mendon to Bellingham, thence turning and running Easterly by and with said County road to the Eastern abutment of the bridge across Muddy Brook, thence turning and running South 12 1/2° East twenty five rods and fourteen links to a stake and stones near a large rock at land of the aforesaid Warren Esty, bounded Easterly in land of Willard H. Brown thence Westerly by and with and bounded Southerly on land of the aforesaid Warren Esty, to the point of beginning.
