premises with all the privileges & appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Augustus J. Davenport & his heirs & assigns to their own use and behoof forever. And I do for myself and my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said Grantee and his heirs & assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrance; that I have good right to sell & convey the same as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs executors & administrators shall warrant & defend the same to the said Grantee & his heirs & assigns forever against the lawful claims & demands of all persons. And for the consideration aforesaid I Martha E. Mann wife of the said Horace Mann do hereby release unto the said Grantee his heirs & assigns all right of or to both dower & homestead in the granted premises.
