Aldrich Marcus M. Know all men by these presents, that I Marcus M.  
to Aldrich, of the Town of Mendon, in the County of Worcester  
Julius A. George and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of  
One dollar and other valuable considerations paid by Julius  
A. George, of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
knowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, and convey  
unto the said Julius A. George, a certain tract or parcel  
of land situated in the village of said Mendon, and  
bounded and described as follows; viz: Beginning at the  
Southwest corner of land of the heirs of George Rawson,  
thence Southerly sixty four feet and four inches to the North-  
west corner of land of John Barry, thence Northerly, bound-  
ing Westerly on land of the grantee sixty five feet to a cor-  
ner, thence Easterly, bounding Northerly on land of the  
grantee, nineteen feet and one inch to the point of begin-  
ning. It is a condition of this deed that the grantee shall  
build a good and substantial fence between the granted  
premises and the grantor's other land. To have and  
to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and  
appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Julius A.  
George and his heirs and assigns, to their own use and  
behoof forever. And I do hereby, for myself and my heirs,  
executors and administrators, covenant with the said  
grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully  
seized in fee simple of the granted premises, that they  
are free from all incumbrances, except the condition  
stated, that I have good right to sell and convey the same  
as aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs, executors,  
and administrators shall warrant and defend the same  
to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever  
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
