Shirley Stiles E. Know all men by these presents, that I, Stiles E. Shirley,
to Geo. M. Taft of Mendon, in the County of Worcester, and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of One dollar and other valuable considerations paid by George M. Taft, of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George M. Taft, Three certain tracts or parcels of land, with the buildings standing thereon, situated in Mendon Village in the town of Mendon, aforesaid, on the northerly side of Hastings street (so called). And being the same premises and all the same premises described in a deed from Gustavus B. Williams and Gustavus B. Williams, Trustee, to me, dated May 4th A.D. 1893, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Book 1408, Page 604, to which deed and the record thereof reference is hereby had for a more particular description of the granted premises. To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said George M. Taft and his heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever. And I hereby, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrance, except the taxes of 1893, and also a mortgage to Mr. Morse for two thousand dollars, on which 6 moe. interest has been paid - and which the grantee agrees to assume and pay, that I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, except as above. And for the consideration aforesaid, I, Mary A. Shirley, wife of the aforesaid Stiles E. Shirley, hereby release unto the grantee and his heirs and assigns all right of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises. In witness whereof, we, the said Stiles E. Shirley and Mary A.
