

Parcel # 2 is a certain parcel of cedar swamp, containing 2 acres and 45 rods, more or less, situated in the Easterly part of said Uxbridge in Post Pond. Cedar Swamp, so called, and is that parcel conveyed to said Perry Wood by George H. Searles, as executor of the last will and testament of Mary C. Johnson, by deed dated June 28, 1882, and recorded in said Registry, Book 1162, Page 102. Parcel # 3 is a certain parcel of land, situated in the Westerly part of said Mendon, on the Southerly side of said turnpike road, containing 13 acres, more or less, and is that parcel conveyed to said Perry Wood by Henry M. Taft, by deed dated January 4, 1871, and recorded in said Registry, Book 831, Page 522. Parcel # 4 is a certain parcel of woodland situated in the Westerly part of said Mendon, containing 6 acres and 59 rods, more or less, and is that parcel conveyed to Austin Wood, by Luke S. Farnum by deed dated November 7, 1881, and recorded in said Registry, Book 1192, Page 595. Parcel # 5 is a certain parcel of land, with the house thereon, situated in the Westerly part of said Mendon, on the Northerly side of said turnpike road, containing 13 acres and 18 rods, more or less, and is that parcel conveyed to said Perry Wood by Charles D. Wood, by deed dated March 25, 1851, and recorded in said Registry, Book 514, Pages 626 and 627. Parcel # 6 is a certain parcel of wood and sprout land, situated partly in said Mendon and partly in said Uxbridge, containing 18 acres and 72 rods, more or less, and is that parcel conveyed to said Perry Wood by Charles D. Wood, by deed dated November 3, 1854, and recorded in said Registry, Book 536, Pages 401 and 402. Parcel # 7 is a certain parcel of land, with the buildings thereon, situated on both sides of said turnpike road, in the Western part of said Mendon, containing 27 acres, more or less, being that first parcel described in the deed of Obadiah Wood to Perry Wood, dated April 1, 1845, and recorded in said Registry, Book 412, Page 241. Parcel # 8 is a certain parcel of land, situated on the south side of a turnpike road, in the Western part of
