H. Ellis, James E. Darling, John McDonald, Newman H. Scott and
Edward S. Smith, Trustees of the Evangelical Union in said Men-
don, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto the said Charles H. Ellis, James E. Dar-
ling, John McDonald, Newman H. Scott and Edward S. Smith, Trus-
tees as aforesaid, a certain tract or parcel of land situated on the Eas-
terly side of Main Street in the Village of Mendon and bounded and de-
scribed as follows, viz: Beginning at a point in the Easterly line of said
Main Street at land of the Town of Mendon, thence N. 60° E. 153.3 ft. to a
corner, thence N. 34½° W. 73 ft. to a corner, thence S. 63° W. 147.7 ft. to the af-
fored line of Main Street, thence S. 27¼° E. 71 ft. to the point of beginning.

To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the
