Taft of Mendon, in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations paid by Timothy Osgood of Hopedale, in said County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby GIVE, and GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL C O N V E Y unto the said Timothy Osgood, a certain parcel of land situated in said MENDON, on the southerly side of Mendon Pond, and bounded and described as follows, viz:- Beginning at a drill hole in a rock at said Pond at land this day conveyed by grantor to Clinton R. Scott; thence N. 5 deg. 30. min. W., 49 5-10 feet, to a stake and stones; thence N. 45 deg. W. 100 feet to a stake and stones at other land of grantor, the last two lines bounding on said Scott land; thence S. 53 deg. 30 min. W., 103 feet, to an oak tree; thence N. 73 deg. 15 min. W., 112 5-10 feet, to a stake and stones; thence N. 5 deg. E. 170 5-10 feet, to a drill hole in a rock at said Pond, the last three lines bounding on grantors other land; thence by and with said Pond to the point of beginning. And I hereby for myself and my heirs, executors, and administrators, covenant with the grantee and his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the granted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs, executors, and administrators shall WARRANT and DEFEND the same to the grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
