ALL MEN \mathbf{B} THESE That I Ella G. Kinsley of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, TRUSTEE under the last will of Elizabeth W. Taft, late of said Mendon, deceased, which will was duly proved and allowed by the Probate Court for said County of Worcester, on the fifth day of May, A. D. 1906, do by virtue and in execution of the power to me given in and by said will, and of every other power and authority me hereto enabling, and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty-five dollars to me paid by Wilfred D.
