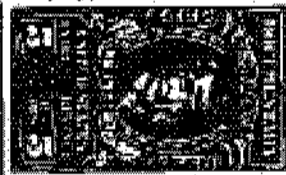

W. Comstock; thence N. 24" W. (43) forty three rods and ten links to land formerly of George H. Darling; thence southerly (13.1/2) twelve and one half rods to a fence; thence S. 37" E. (34) thirty-four rods and (11) links to an angle; thence S. 35.1/3 " E. (10) ten rods and (17) seventeen links to the forementioned road, the last three lines are bounded by land formerly of George H. Darling; thence by said road N. 43.1/3 " E. (10) ten rods and (8) eight links to the place of beginning."

Being all the same premises conveyed by Alice H. Hartshorn to Robert Wright, by deed dated March 31, 1919, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Book 2171, Page 414.

Mary E. Wright's title is derived as heir at law of said Robert Wright, see Worcester Probate Case #127280.
