 setts, Yeoman - being advanced in age, but of sound &
 perfect mind and memory, blessed be God for the same,
 do make and publish this my last Will and Testament - in
 manner and form following - that is to say -

1st I give, and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Rhoda
 Gould and the household furniture and personal appurtenances, that
 she now enjoys, and is in her possession - take at her dis-
 posal at my decease - also her maintenance and nursing for
 natural life, as will more fully appear, in the Bond which
 I shall execute against Curtis Gould having even date with these
 presents.

2nd I give and bequeath unto my Oldest son
 Curtis Gould - the other half of my farm which he this
 present date holds a Mortgagee Deed of the other half,
 upon condition he shall give a certain Bond having even
 date with these presents, for my maintenance & my Wife
 Rhoda - during our natural lives - and that said Bond, as
 above mentioned, to be void, if there should be any other dis-
 posal, of the above undivided half - which is intended for
 the said Curtis, and he, to come into quiet & peaceable possession
 at our decease - upon the fulfilment of said Bond. -
 Also one half of stock and farming tools now in my pos-
 session.

3rd I give and bequeath unto my second son,
 the sum of one dollar - together with what he has already
 got, is his full portion out of my Estate, excepting what
 is found, as the residue of my personal Estate at our
 decease - then the same to be equally divided between my
 two sons Curtis & Nahum G. Gould - the said Curtis to pay all
 my just debts & funeral charges.

And I do hereby appoint my beloved Wife Rhoda
 Gould my sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testa-

ment - hereby reading all former Wills by me made.
