And lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my well beloved Wife Seloe Ammidon and my two Sons Otho and Phillip Ammidon to be my joint & severall Executors of this my last Will and Testament ratifying and confirming this and more other to be in my last Will and Testament -

I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Wife Seloe Ammidon the sole use and improvement of the land and Store therein Standing therein lying & being on the southerly side of the road leading by my now dwelling house and on the westerly side of the Providence road so called, bounded Easterly by said Providence Road, Northerly by the first mentioned road, westerly by land of the heirs of George Smith deceased, southerly by said heirs and Lewis Millers land, and to be by her use, let or improved as she may think best during her natural life -

 Fourthly I give to Lydia Willard wife of Solomon Willard and to her heirs the Land and Buildings which were set off to satisfy an Execution against William Young being fifty acres more or less lying in Worcester aforesaid -  
 Fifthly I give to Lydia Johnson the wife of Joshua Johnson my brother &c her heirs
