 ledge do hereby sell and convey unto him the said George Taft  
 his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land  
 situate in Mendon containing by Estimation one acre be-  
 the same more or less and is bounded as follows (viz) beginning  
 at a heap of stones on the easterly side of a road leading from  
 the first to the second prominent in said Mendon being the north-  
 west corner of the premises thence running easterly nine rod, and  
 one half to a heap of stones thence southerly fifteen rod, to a  
 heap of stones thence westerly ten rod, and one half to said road  
 thence northerly fifteen rod to the first mentioned bounds and  
 bounded westerly by said road and on all other parts by land  
 belonging to the heirs of Seth Taft deceased also all the buildings  
 on the premises - Also a certain plot of land containing about  
 ninety five rods, situate on the westerly side of said road bounded  
 east by said road nine rod, and one half northerly by a road  
 leading to Taft's pond twelve rod to said pond westerly by said pond  
 six rod, and one half southerly by land of the heir of said Deceased  
 about twelve rod, to said road - Also the plot that now stand on
