dollar paid by Henry Gof of Brattlebury in the State of Vermont
Yeoman the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give
grant sell and convey unto the said Henry Gof his heirs & assigns
one undivided half of the farm on which I and my Father now
live and improve consisting of sundry tracts or parcels of lands lying
partly in the Town of Mendon and partly in the Town of Upton being
the same land I purchased of my Father Gideon Gof and deeded
to me by him April 8. 1806 reference to his several deeds for a more
particular description and boundaries thereof together with one
half of the buildings thereon standing —
