

and convey unto the said Johnson Legg his Heirs and Assigns, forever
 a certain tract or piece of land situate in Mendon aforesaid, containing
 by estimation thirty five acres be the same more or less, and is bounded
 as follows, to wit, beginning at the North-west corner of Thomas Taft's
 land on the East side of the road leading by the grantor's dwelling house,
 thence Easterly on land of the said Taft about forty six rods to the North-
 east corner of the said Taft's home farm, thence Southerly on land
 of the said Taft about twenty four rods to a stake and stones by Lisa
 Fletcher's land, thence Northeasterly on land of the said Fletcher as the
 fence now stands about sixty rods to the little pond, so called, thence Northerly
 on said pond and land of Douglass Marsh about forty rods to a stake and
 stones, thence Westerly four rods to a piece of land that was set off to Joseph
 Marsh & wife out of their Mother's thirds, thence on the South line of said land
 to the South-west corner of the same, thence Northerly about twelve rods along
 the side hill, so called, as the wall now stands to the North side of said side
 hill to a larger rock in the corner of the wall it being the Northeast cor-
 ner of said side hill, bounding on land of the grantor by the last men-
 tioned line, thence on the North side of said side hill as the wall now stands
 about fifty rods to the above mentioned road, bounding North on land of
 the grantor by the last mentioned line, thence on said road about forty
 rods to the first mentioned bounds, and likewise one other piece of land
 on the West side of said road at the Southeast corner of the garden lot,
 so called, containing by estimation twenty four rods be the same more
 or less, beginning at the said Southeast corner of said lot, thence Wester-
 ly about 3 rods to an elm stump, thence Northerly about seven rods to a
 stake and stones, thence Easterly about four rods to the road, bounding
 on land of the grantor by the three last mentioned lines, thence South-
 erly on said road about seven rods to the first bounds. — To have
 and to hold the same to the said Johnson Legg his Heirs and Assigns
 to his and their us and behoof forever. And we do covenant with the
 said Johnson Legg his Heirs and Assigns, that we are lawfully seized
 in fee of the Premises, that they are free of all Incumbrances, and that
 we will warrant and defend the same to the said Johnson Legg his
 Heirs and Assigns forever, against the lawful Claims and demands
