 Know all men by these presents that I Simmon Whedock of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts yeoman in consideration of fifteen hundred dollars to me paid by Hanson S. Freeman of said Mendon yeoman the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Hanson S. Freeman his heirs and assigns four certain tracts or parcels of land with the appurtenances situate in said Mendon. The first of said tracts of land with a dwelling house barn and other buildings thereon contains about twenty three acres be the same more or less and is bounded as follows to wit. beginning at a corner of the wall on the East side of the road leading from the North Parish in said Mendon to the South Parish meeting house in said town at a corner of land of the heirs of Levi Albee being the Northwest corner of the premises thence running by and with said road Southwesterly till it comes to the road which leads by the house owned by Nahor Fletcher thence by and with said last mentioned road till it comes to land occupied by Leason Green and owned by the heirs of the late Elijah Hayward deceased thence North 15° East fifty seven rods to land owned by Moses T.
