 containing one acre more or less and bounded; Beginning at the road leading
 from the old turnpike by where Ellis & George Tafts now lives at land of Amariah
 Tafts, thence Westerly as the wall stands and bounding Northerly on said Tafts land
 nineteen rods lacking one foot to stones at the end of a partition wall at land
 now or lately of widow Lee thence Southeasterly on said widow Lee land
 fifteen rods and one quarter to a stake and stones on the Northeasterly side of
 said road leading by Ellis & George Tafts, thence running Northeasterly by said
 road nineteen rods lacking one foot to the bounds first mentioned with all the
