from the old turnpike by where Ellis & George Tafts now lives at land of Amarah
Tafts, thence Westerly as the wall stands and bounding Northerly on said Tafts land
nineteen rods lacking one foot to stones at the end of a partition wall at land
now or lately of widow Lee thence Southeasterly on said widow Lee land
sixteen rods and one quarter to a stake and stones on the Northeasterly side of
said road leading by Ellis & George Tafts, thence running Northeasterly by said
