 John T. Gaskell Accountant. in consideration of eighty seven dollars and twenty  
 five cents paid by John T. Gaskell to said Mendon Farmer the  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby give grant  
 bargain sell and convey unto the said John T. Gaskell his heirs  
 and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situated in said  
 Mendon on the Southwesterly side of a County road leading from the  
 Town Hall in Mendon to Uxbridge and bounded as follows to  
 wit: beginning at a point upon said road near a large rock  
 thence running Southwesterly parallel with the Easterly side of the  
 James dwelling house formerly a shop and twenty two feet dis-  
 tant from the same one hundred and twenty seven feet to a  
 stake. thence turning and running Easterly and bounded  
 Southwesterly by land now or formerly of Dennis James fifty eight  
 feet to a stake and stones at land now or formerly of Brigham  
 and Alvin T. Staples. thence turning and running Northerly  
 and bounded Easterly by said Staples land one hundred and  
 twenty seven feet to the road before mentioned. thence turn-  
 ing and running Northerly and bounded Northerly by said  
 road seventy feet to the first mentioned bound. being the  
 same premises conveyed to grantor by the Trustees of the  
 Methodist Episcopal Church in said Mendon by their authorized

 granted premises that they are free from all incumbran-  
 ces. that I have good right to sell and convey the same to  
 the said John T. Gaskell as aforesaid and that I will and  
 my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and  
 defend the same to the said John T. Gaskell his heirs and  
 assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands
