

our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty five by Stephen Torrey Administrator &c of Cumberland in the County of Providence against Seth Hastings Gayward of the City of Detroit in the State of Michigan for the sum of eleven hundred and eighty three dollars and ninety two cents damage and costs of suit taxed at ninety nine dollars and eighty four cents seized and taken all the right in equity which the said Seth Hastings Gayward had on the eleventh day of September in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty three being the time when the same was attached on mesne process of redeeming the following described mortgaged real estate to wit; one undivided third part of the seven several tracts or parcels of land situate in Mendon in said County of Worcester with the buildings thereon.

The first ^{tract} was the homestead of the late Mary M. Gayward deceased, containing four acres more or less, on the Southerly side of the Boston and Hartford County road so called, bounded on the North by said road, on the South by land of Augustus Knight, on the East by land of Dennis Edmees, and on the West by another road. Second tract contains 4 acres more or less and is bounded North by land of said Knight, South by land of Gilbert Gaskill East by land of Joseph R. Wheelock and West by a road.

The third tract contains one fourth of an acre more or less with dwelling house thereon now or formerly occupied by Patrick Wallis, bounded on the North by the first mentioned road, West by land of Abigail Staples, South by land of Joseph R. Wheelock and East by land of heirs of Nancy W. Thayer deceased.

The fourth tract is the "Training Field" so called containing 16 acres more or less, bounded Northerly by the first named road, Southerly by land of George and Ellis Taft, Easterly by land of Eli Pond and Westerly by a road.
