

also one other piece of swamp land lying North-  
erly of the house of the late Verville Taft and bounded  
as follows viz. Northerly by land of Christopher Daniel  
and land belonging to the heirs of Verville Taft, Easter-  
ly by land of Elizabeth M. Taft and land belonging  
to the heirs of Verville Taft, Southerly by land of Elias  
and George Taft and Westerly by land of Thomas Taft  
containing five acres more or less.

To have  
and to hold the above granted premises with the  
privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the  
said Mercy D. Ross her heirs and assigns to her  
and their use and behoof forever and I the said gran-  
tor for myself and my heirs executors and adminis-  
trators do covenant with the said grantee and her  
heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee  
simple of the aforesigned premises, that they are free  
from all incumbrances, that I have a good right to sell  
and convey the same to the said grantee and her heirs  
and assigns forever as aforesaid, and that I will and  
my heirs executors and administrators shall war-  
rant and defend the same to the said grantee her  
heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claime  
and demands of all persons.
