

release and forever quit claim unto the said
 Simeon Wheelock his heirs and assigns, a certain
 tract of land laying in Mendon aforesaid and
 in common and undivided with the heirs of Levi
 Albee late of Mendon deceased said lot containing
 about fifteen acres of land with an old house and
 barn on the same and laying on the road lead-
 ing from Mendon North Parish to the South Par-
 ish and bounded Westerly on said road North-
 erly on land of Alvin Taft and then on land
 of Clanson Freeman to the road first above men-
 tioned being the land that belonged to Levi
 Albee late of said Mendon deceased and also
 about two acres of woodland laying in dam
 swamp so called and reference to the old deed
 for the boundary of said land. To have and to
 hold the aforegranted premises with all the privi-
 leges and appurtenances thereto belonging to him
 the said Simeon Wheelock his heirs and assigns
 forever, so that neither we the said Elijah and
 Sarah aforesaid nor our heirs or any other per-
 son or persons claiming from or under us or
 them, or in the name right or stead of us or
 them shall or will by any way or means have claim
 or demand any right or title to the aforesaid prem-
 ises or their appurtenances or to any part or par-
 cel thereof forever. In witness whereof we the said
