Know all men by these presents that Eras T. Abel of Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massachusetts by Charles A. Henry of Uxbridge in said County as Attorney of said Eras T. Abel by virtue of a Power of Attorney and Power of sale contained in a certain mortgage deed hereinafter referred to in consideration of six hundred and seventy dollars paid by Albert F. Henry of Uxbridge aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, demise, release, and forever quit claim unto the said Albert F. Henry his heirs and assigns all the right title claim and demand of said Eras T. Abel in and to all that certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situated in Alberville in said Mendon, and bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at a heap of stones on the road leading from the School house to Mendon thence S. 26° W. twelve rods seven links to the point of intersection of said road with the road leading to Uxbridge, thence on said road N. 76¹/₂° W. fourteen rods thence N. 18° E thirteen rods thence S. 72° E fifteen rods eleven links to the place of beginning containing one acre and twenty four rods and are the same premises described in the mortgage deed of Eras T. Abel to Charles A. Henry above referred to dated July 1 1864 and recorded in the Registry of Deeds for Worcester County Book 693 Page 137 and are hereby conveyed under and by virtue of the powers granted to said Charles A. Henry by said mortgage deed.

To have and to hold the above released premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Albert F. Henry his heirs and assigns forever; so that neither the said Eras T. Abel nor his heirs, or any other person or persons claiming from or under him or them, in the prime, right or plead of him or them, shall or will, by any way or means, have claim, or demand any right or title to the aforesaid premises, or their appurtenances, or to any part or parcel thereof forever. That I will warrant and defend the same from all circumstances so far as made by me but not otherwise. In witness whereof, the said Eras T. Abel, by his Attorney Charles A. Henry have hereunto set his hand and seal this twenty third day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy.
