1859 and bounding Northerly on said Cosgrove land nineteen (19)  
rods lacking one foot to stones at the end of a partition wall at  
land now or late of widow Lee thence southeasterly on said Lee  
land sixteen and one fourth (16 1/4) rods to a stake and stones on  
the northeasterly side of said road leading by George Taft thence  
northeasterly by said road nineteen (19) rods lacking one foot to
