to a certain parcel of land with the buildings thereon contain-
ing about seventy five acres situated on Misquoc Hill (so
called) in said Mendon bounded Northerly by land - nathan George and land of Abby Madden and land of John
Burley Easterly by land of said Abby Madden land of John
Burley and by the road leading from Upton road to
house of Perley Taft Southerly by land of said John Burley
and Westerly by land of said John Burley land of Luther
Taft and land of Harrison Wood a part of said premises
above described being known as the Goss place and the re-
mainder known as the Albee pasture and being the same
premises and all the same described in a certain deed &
mortgage said deed being dated April 1 1864 recorded with
