And I do hereby for myself and my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said grantees and his heirs and assigns that the granted premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me, and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantees and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other. and for the consideration aforesaid I Debora Albee wife of the Grantor do hereby release unto the said Grantee and his heirs and assigns all right of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises.
