section of said streets, thence Easterly by the Northerly  
line of said Endicott street one hundred and ninety five  
and six tenths feet to a point thence on a line at right-  
angles with said Endicott street Northerly seventy four  
feet, thence Westerly on a line parallel to said Endicott  
street to said Ward street, thence Southerly by the Easterly  
line of said Ward street to the place of beginning. Being  
the same estate conveyed to grantor by Bridget Trainor by  
her deed dated September 13<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1867 and recorded in the
