

granted premises with all the improvements that may be thereon at public auction such sale to be on or near the premises without further notice or demand except giving notice of the time and place of sale once at least in each of three successive weeks in one newspaper printed in the County of Worcester and in their own names or as the attorneys of the Grantor or his heirs or assigns for that purpose by three persons duly authorized to convey the same or any part thereof absolutely and in fee simple to the purchaser or purchasers accordingly and out of the money arising from such sale to retain all sum then secured by this deed (whether then or thereafter payable) together with interest and all costs of any suit either on said note or mortgage and all expenses incurred in such sale.

Paying the surplus if any to the Grantor or his assigns and such sale shall forever bar the Grantor and all persons claiming by or under him from all right and interest in the premises. It being mutually agreed that the Grantee their successors or assigns may purchase at laid sale and that no other purchaser shall be answerable for the application of the purchase money. And provided also that until some break of the conditions of this deed the Grantee shall have no right to enter and take possession of the premises.
