one hundred and ten dollars paid by George H. Sibley of Worces-
ter, County of Worcester and Commonwealth aforesaid, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain,
sell and convey unto the said George H. Sibley and his heirs, ex-
ecutors, administrators and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of
land with the buildings thereon, situated in the Easterly part
of the City of Worcester on Shrewsbury street, so called, and bound-
ed and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the South
and Westerly corner of said lot, said corner being the South
and Easterly corner of a lot sold by Holmes & Walker by their
deed, bearing date April 8th 1853 to Thomas Kelley; thence run-
ning in a Northerly direction by land now or formerly of Thomas
Kelley forty five (45) feet, thence turning and running in an
Easterly direction forty three and one half (43.5) feet to a point
thirty five (35) feet from the line of Shrewsbury street; thence
turning and running in a Southerly direction by land former-
ly of John Sawtell thirty five (35) feet to said Shrewsbury street;
thence turning and running in a Westerly direction on the line
of said Shrewsbury street forty five feet to the place of beginning.
