

Connecticut, plaintiff before our Justice of our Superior Court holden for or within our County of Worcester aforesaid, at Worcester upon the second Monday of December, A.D. 1879, by the consideration of our said Court, recovered judgment for his title and possession of and in a certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situated in Mendon in said County of Worcester, bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning at a stake in the corner of the wall at N.W. corner of the premises on the Easterly side of the road leading from Mendon past the house of Arnold Taft, Esqr. at the S.W. corner of a young orchard; thence running Easterly by and with the wall to a corner of wall; thence running Southerly by and with the wall to a corner of wall; thence running Westerly by and with the wall to the road before mentioned; thence Northerly by and with said road to the place of beginning, containing half an acre more or less with the shop standing on the West side of the road aforesaid and opposite to the premises above described, together with the land upon which the same stands, against Chloe A. Staples of Mendon, Widow, defendant, who had unjustly withheld, put out or removed the said plaintiff from his possession thereof; also at the said Court, recovered judgment for twenty seven dollars and eighty three cents for costs, as to us hath been made to appear of record; we command you therefore, that without delay, you cause the said plaintiff to have possession of and in the said messuage or tenement, with the appurtenances; we also command you, that of the goods, chattels or lands of the said defendant, within your precinct, at the value thereof in money, you cause the said plaintiff to be paid and satisfied the aforesaid sum of \$27.83, which to the said plaintiff was adjudged for his costs, and interest thereon from the fifteenth day of December, A.D. 1879, being the day on which the judgment aforesaid was rendered, with twenty five cents more for this writ, and thereof also to satisfy yourself for your own fees. And for want of such goods, chattels or lands of the said defendant to be by her shewn unto you, or found within your precinct to the acceptance of the said plaintiff to satisfy the aforesaid sum, we command you to take the body of the said defendant and her commit unto our jail in Worcester, in our County of Worcester, or any jail in your precinct aforesaid, and detain in your custody within our said jail
