Eliza A. Hall her heirs and assigns all the right, title, claim or
demand which I may have in and unto the premises hereby
conveyed, under or by virtue of the homestead exemption laws
of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and also all right claim
or possibility of dower in said premises.
