To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Ellen McKenna and her heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever. And we do hereby, for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said Grantee and her heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances save two mortgages held by the heirs of Christopher Daniels, and both amounting to Five Hundred and Fifty Dollars; that we have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Grantee and her heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons except as above stated. And for the consideration aforesaid, we, Clifton W. Ross, wife of the said Clifton W. Ross and Jenny - Ross wife of the said Irving F. Ross, do hereby release unto the said Grantee and - heirs and assigns all right of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises.
