

Taft Samuel B. Know all men by these presents, that I, Samuel B. Taft of  
to Uxbridge, in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of  
Geo. A. De Wolf Twenty-seven Hundred and Fifty (2750) Dollars paid by George H.  
De Wolf of Mendon, in said Commonwealth, the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
the said George H. De Wolf, a certain farm with the buildings thereon  
situated in the Southerly part of said Mendon, containing one hun-  
dred and forty-three acres more or less, and bounded as follows, viz: Be-  
ginning at a corner of land of heirs of Robert P. Williams, on East side  
of road leading through the premises; thence on said Williams land  
 $S. 80^{\circ} E.$  twenty rods; thence  $S. 79\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$  eighteen rods and eighteen links;  
thence  $S. 20^{\circ} W.$  five rods and 10 links; thence South twenty-three rods to  
land of Willis Southwick; thence on said Southwick's land  $S. 35^{\circ} W.$   
twenty-five rods and 18 links; thence  $S. 89^{\circ} E.$  nine rods and 20 links;  
thence  $S. 1^{\circ} W.$  twenty-five rods and 20 links; thence  $S. 48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W.$  eight  
rods and 11 links; thence  $S. 67\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W.$  sixteen rods; thence  $S. 78\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W.$  six rods  
and 10 links; thence  $S. 2^{\circ} E.$  one rod + 15 links to a rock at corner of land  
formerly of Edward L. Staples; thence on said Staples land  $S. 74^{\circ} W.$  ten  
rods and 5 links to stake and stones; thence  $S. 77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W.$  seven rods + 23  
links to stake + stones; thence  $S. 49^{\circ} W.$  twelve rods + 20 links to stake +  
stones at land of Thompson Taft; thence on said Taft's land  $N. 50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W.$   
thirty-two rods + 10 links to land formerly of Abijah Esty; thence  
Northwesterly about one hundred and ninety-six rods on said Esty's  
land and land formerly of Mary and Olive Hayward to land of Am-  
dre Southwick; thence on said Southwick's land  $N. 7\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} W.$  eleven rods +  
15 links to stones at land of Samuel Bassett; thence  $N. 80\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$  forty-six  
rods on said Bassett's land and land formerly of Sullivan H. Taft;  
thence  $N. 2^{\circ} W.$  fifty-four rods on said Taft's land and land formerly of  
Lewis Wood; thence Easterly on said Woods, Alma H. Aldrich's, Re-  
becca A. Robinson's, Luther E. Taft's, Nathan G. Daniels and heirs of  
Royal M. Wheelock land about one hundred and twelve rods to land  
of Robert Brown; thence Easterly by various lines on said Brown's  
land to land formerly of Jane E. Alexander; thence to said road;  
thence Northeasterly to the point of beginning. Reserving and excepting  
however from this conveyance the rights of the public to use the road  
above mentioned. The dwelling house and lot formerly owned by Ste-  
phen C. Taft, and the tomb and burial lot, all situated within the  
above described premises. Being those premises conveyed to me by  
George H. Day, by mortgagee, by deed dated April 22, 1890, and re-
